Major Decisions and Outcomes: Welcome Norway!

- Approved Norway's request to join GMI.
 - 41st GMI Partner.
 - Norway will participate in the Oil & Gas Subcommittee.



Major Decisions and Outcomes: GMI Partnership Expo

- Supported Canada's offer to host next Expo in Vancouver (anticipated February 2013).
- Agreed to similar model for previous Expos:
 - Expo Task Force.
 - Early determination of Expo themes and objectives (i.e., technology, action plans).
 - Site visits.
 - Strategic outreach mechanisms (e.g., dedicated website, newsletter, trade publications).
 - Subcommittee identification of sector-specific session topics/speakers and projects.
 - Promote beyond GMI members.



Major Decisions and Outcomes: Municipal Wastewater

- Supported elevating wastewater task force to subcommittee status.
 - United States will serve as interim chair, while ASG queries Partners interested in serving as members or chairs.
- Tasked forthcoming Municipal Wastewater Subcommittee with developing a sectorspecific action plan that includes ongoing coordination with Agriculture and Landfill Subcommittees.



Major Decisions and Outcomes: Action Plans

- Reached consensus to use new GMI Partner Action Plan guidance.
 - ASG shall incorporate additional language on leveraging existing tools/resources from other climate initiatives and/or national plans (e.g., NAMAs, LEDS).
- Encouraged completion of GMI Partner Action Plans prior to 2013 Expo.
- Suggested periodic updates should be performed, as necessary.
- Determined GMI Partner Action Plans should be posted on the website.

Major Decisions and Outcomes: GMI Futures

Organization

 Supported continuation of Unites States' role as Steering Committee chair and ASG host, with flexibility and encouragement for Partners to have opportunity in the future.

Financial Support

- Tasked ASG with development of white paper to explore financing options for Steering Committee consideration.
 - Shall include Subcommittee consultation.



Major Decisions and Outcomes: GMI Futures (con't)

- Short Lived Climate Forcers (SLCFs)
 Initiative
 - ASG will endeavor to keep Steering Committee and Partners informed.
 - Steering Committee delegates should keep their leadership informed as effort evolves.



Charge to ASG: Outreach & Communications

Website

- Work with Partners and Subcommittees to obtain information, particularly as it relates to country resources and project success stories.
 - Conduct periodic check-in with Partners for activities to contribute.
- Continue to highlight PN members.
- Add UNFCCC linkage (e.g., complementary relationship with GMI).
- Enhance existing financing information.
- Periodically update and report PN changes to Partners.

Charge to ASG: GMI Partnership Expo

- Convene an Expo Task Force with membership from Canada (host country), other interested Partner Countries, and PN members.
- Pursue strategic outreach mechanisms (e.g., dedicated website, newsletter, trade publications).



Charge to ASG: GMI Futures

- Develop white paper to explore financing options.
- Keep Steering Committee and Partners apprised of SLCF developments.



Charge to Partners: Outreach & Communications

- Work directly with the ASG to provide information for the website, particularly as it relates to country resources and project success stories.
- Utilize the newsletter to highlight projects, conferences, or other success stories.
- Undertake outreach activities and provide links to press releases or other new items to the ASG for inclusion on the GMI website.
- Distribute GMI outreach materials and/or make presentations at energy-, environment-, or industryrelated conferences (e.g., side events), especially UNFCCC events.
- Seeking Partner Country participation and Partner Country host for GMI side event at COP17.

Charge to Partners: GMI Partnership Expo

- Provide Expo support :
 - Seek sponsors.
 - Identify/propose project ideas and success stories for Expo project showcase.
 - Conduct in-country marketing and outreach.
 - Commit to attend and support the Expo.



Charge to Partners: Municipal Wastewater

- Evaluate internal interest in serving as Chair of the Municipal Wastewater Subcommittee, or leading future efforts under this sector.
- Actively participate in the Municipal Wastewater Subcommittee.



Charge to Partners: Action Plans

- Designate one official representative for coordinating, developing, and submitting the GMI Partner Action Plan.
- Incorporate and/or leverage existing tools or resources from other climate initiatives or plans into GMI Partner Action Plans.
- Provide periodic updates on GMI Partner Action Plans, as changes occur (e.g., new national policy).
- Endeavor to complete GMI Partner Action Plans prior to 2013 Expo.

Charge to Subcommittees: Outreach & Communications
