




Upcoming Activities – ZACK project

Launch of National Plan "Dominicana Limpia" June 27th, 2017

Dominicana Limpia Plan, is an initiative that aims to turn the country into a "clean, orderly and environmentally friendly country", a program that includes items valued at 1,815 million Dominican pesos (USD 38 million) and whose first 318 million Dominican pesos (USD 6.6 million) will be contributed this year and remaining in items of 500 million (USD 10.482 million) until 2020.

Five key points of National Plan "Dominicana Limpia"

Investment

the budget of the municipalities for 2017 is about 17 billion pesos (USD356.9 million), which means an increase of 2.85% in the annual budget of the municipalities.

Waste for electricity generation

2,600 tons/day of waste could be used for the electricity generation of the Punta Catalina Plant, which could also be purchased from the country's municipalities. 2,600 tons of waste represent approximately 60% of the waste produced daily in Gran Santo Domingo, the country's largest producer.

Three geographical points

The plan indicates that in about 90 days an implementation project will be presented and that they will focus on three priority points: **Gran Santo Domingo, Santiago and La Altagracia province**.

Five key points of National Plan "Dominicana Limpia"

Regional landfills

Eliminate municipal waste. Landfills will become provincial or regional. At this stage, 18 landfills, 25 municipalities and 62 municipal districts will be involved ".

Recycling

As a cross-cutting theme, the theme of recycling and collection of the garbage collection service will be strengthened. Up to 51 percent of the garbage produced in the country can be recycled. "
