

GLOBAL METHANE INITIATIVE OIL & GAS SUBCOMMITTEE MEETING

Oil & Gas Subcommittee 27 March 2025 Geneva, Switzerland

MEETING SUMMARY

The Global Methane Initiative (GMI) Oil & Gas Subcommittee Meeting held a hybrid meeting (inperson and virtual attendees) in Geneva, Switzerland, on 27 March 2025. The meeting was held in conjunction with the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) 12th Session of the Group of Experts on Gas. Mr. James Diamond of Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC) and Co-Chair of the GMI Oil & Gas Subcommittee led the meeting and was joined by representatives from 20 countries, including Algeria, Austria, Canada, China, Colombia, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Ireland, Italy, Mexico, Nigeria, Norway, Poland, Republic of Korea, Russia, Switzerland, United Kingdom, and the United States. A list of the participants is provided in Annex I.

The purpose of the meeting was to provide participants with updates on the activities of the Subcommittee, including the identified priorities of the 2025-2030 Oil & Gas Subcommittee Action Plan, hear from Partner Countries and Strategic Partners about their recent methane mitigation work, and review new GMI tools and resources. The agenda is included in Annex II.

Mr. James Diamond, GMI Oil & Gas Subcommittee Co-Chair, ECCC (Canada), opened the meeting by welcoming participants. Mr. Diamond provided an overview of GMI and highlighted GMI's celebration of 20 years of methane action. Mr. Diamond then moved on to the Strategic Partner Updates, in which several partners spoke, including Tomás de Oliveira Bredariol, International Energy Agency; Carlos de Regules, Climate and Clean Air Coalition; Georgie Passalaris, United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP); and Giulia Ferrini, UNEP. Each partner provided updates on their organizations' recent methane mitigation efforts.

Dr. Grace Mbungu, Africa Policy Research Institute, provided an update on methane mitigation projects currently underway in the oil and gas sector in Nigeria. Mr. Diamond then addressed Subcommittee business, providing an overview of new GMI oil and gas resources, including the Simplified Methane Assessment and Reporting Tool (SMART Plus) and the new Leak Detection and Repair (LDAR) Training Modules. Mr. Diamond reviewed the identified priorities of the upcoming 2025-2030 Subcommittee Sprint Action Plan and closed the meeting by reviewing upcoming oil and gas-related events and encouraging participants to provide feedback on how GMI can be a resource to them.
