#### U.S. Coal Sector Action Plan for GMI

- Updated; will soon be available for dissemination
- ➤ Reporting of greenhouse gas emissions from U.S. underground coal mines, under EPA GHG Reporting Program
  - Data collection by mines in 2011; Mines report to USEPA by September 28, 2012

- Coal Subcommittee Action Plan
- ➤ Planning for Coal Policy and Technical Sessions at GMI Expo in Vancouver, 12 – 15 March 2013
  - Committee developed for organizing coal breakout sessions
  - Good number of abstracts received



## Recent Activities in China and Mongolia

#### China

- Comprehensive feasibility studies at five sites
- Success story: Feasibility study at Songzao Coal Mines, Chongqing. Based on results of this study, CQEIG is moving forward with joint venture for CMM to LNG plant
- Two Pre-feasibility studies launched
- Data collection and analyses: inventory of abandoned mines in Shanxi Province, through grant with University of Colorado Boulder

### Mongolia

- Grant to Mongolia Nature and Environment Consortium (MNEC) to conduct a CMM resource assessment and develop an emissions inventory
- Pre-feasibility study launched

## Recent Activities: Russia, Ukraine, Kazakhstan

#### Russia

- Grant to Uglemetan to improve measurement of VAM emissions in Kuznetsk coal basin
- Pre-feasibility launched for mines in the Kuzbass

#### Ukraine

- Finalizing pre-feasibility at Zhandovskaya Mine
- Pre-feasibility study launched for mine in Donetsk basin

#### Kazakhstan

Pre-feasibility study underway in Karaganda coal basin

## Recent Activities: India, Poland

#### India

- February 2012 site visit to CMM Clearinghouse, CIMFR grantee, and Moonidih mine.
- Finalizing two grants with Southern Illinois University and Central Institute of Mining and Fuel Research (CIMFR)
- Support for CMM Clearinghouse extended

#### Poland

- On-going grant to Central Mining Institute (CMI) to study degasification at Pawlowice
- Completed CMI grant on VAM Emissions at Ten Gassy Coal Mines in Poland to be published in FY13
