- U.S. Involvement in Coal Mine Methane













- EPA collaborated with Japan's New Energy and Industrial Technology Development Organization (NEDO), the Australian Greenhouse Office, & China Coal Information Institute (CCII) on Coal Mine Methane Tech Transfer and Project Development Workshop in Beijing (December 2005)
- EPA participated in UNECE Meetings of the Ad Hoc Group of Experts on CMM and the Task Force on Improving Mine Safety through the Extraction and Use of CMM in Geneva (January 2006)
 - EPA developing three case studies to examine the economic and safety benefits of incorporating methane recovery strategies at US Coal Mines (ongoing)



- EPA continues to support Methane to Markets
 core activities
 - Completing draft of "Global CMM Overview: Activities and Opportunities", which will be available on the web for comments in June, 2006
 - Developing web-based Global Database of CMM Projects
 - Preparing white paper on ownership and regulatory issues in Partner countries based on completed questionnaires
 - Supporting the development of key strategies for the CMM sector for a successful Partnership Expo



- TDA provided technical assistance grant to the Shanxi Jincheng Anthracite Coal Mining Group in China to develop a 120 MW CBM and CMM power plant at the Sihe Mine
 - Caterpillar and Jincheng announced contract for engines (May 2006)
- TDA and EPA are in discussion with Government of India about establishing a CBM/CMM
 Clearinghouse in India
 - TDA sponsored two orientation visits to the US from India
 - TDA funded a CBM feasibility study in India
 - US EPA and TDA visited India for discussions (May 2006)



- EPA funded a pre-feasibility study to evaluate use of ventilation air methane (VAM) in Huainan China
 - EPA site visit (August 2005)
 - Pre-feasibility study under review by mining group and technology vendors
- USAID project in **Ukraine** to demonstrate the technical effectiveness of enhanced horizontal **drilling techniques**.
 - Drill shipped to Ukraine (March 2006)
- TDA awarded grant for feasibility study in Donbass coal basin, Ukraine for CMM and CBM (October, 2005)
 - US contractor conducted site visit (April 2006)



- EPA is funding a cooperative agreement with UNECE to promote financing and investment of CMM projects in countries with economies in transition
 - UNECE will kick off mission in Russia with meetings in Moscow and Kemerovo (June 2006)
- EPA continues to support CBM/CMM
 Clearinghouses in China, Russia, and Ukraine
 - PEER in Ukraine will hold workshop to train coal mining community on project finance (June 2006)
 - Uglemetan in Russia will hold international conference on project opportunities (June 19-20, 2006)
 - CBMC in China is planning conference (October 17-18, 2006)

- EPA is sponsoring a Methane to Markets Workshop in Fall 2006
 - Date and location TBD
- EPA is hosting CMM workshop in Western U.S.
 - September 26-27, 2006 Grand Junction, Colorado
 - Primarily domestic audience, but international attendees welcome
