










1 Large Company (Grupo Acerero del Norte) Distribution of production by company size (annually)


Mexican coal market (Metric tons of coal, 2008)


Present and Future demand

Future demand will grow 36 million metric tons (MMT) of coal each year, so we must increment the production by 20 MMT yearly
