- **Update on Administrative Support Group (ASG) Activities:** The ASG will provide an update on new members and new projects under the initiative as well as upcoming events the Initiative is participating in.
- **Action Plans:** To fulfill the requests of the September 2010 Steering Committee meeting, we will be distributing a list of questions from the ASG to help guide each Partner Country action plan. Delegates will have a chance to review the document before the meeting and we will discuss comments during the Webinar.
- **Country-Specific Strategies and Activities:** Partner Countries will have an opportunity, if they choose, to provide a brief update on their activities over the past eight months since the last Subcommittee meeting in Beijing China, and an overview of activities planned for the rest of 2011. Partner Country delegates interested in providing an update should limit their presentation to a maximum of five minutes and should send no more than four PowerPoint slides to the ASG prior to the meeting (asg@globalmethane.org).
- **Planning Technical Agenda for Fall 2011 Meeting:** The ASG is proposing up to one full day of technical session to be held in conjunction with the Fall Subcommittee meetings (exact date and location to be determined). The Subcommittee will discuss their feedback on the following general agenda ideas for the Coal sector: VAM project updates globally; an update on Best Practices Guidelines for Methane Drainage from Coal Mines, including workshops and other activities of the UNECEC Group of Experts on Coal Mine Methane; project financing, and additional suggestions sent ahead of the meeting or brought to it.
- **Follow-up from October 2010 Meeting in Beijing:** In advance of the meeting, the Co-chairs will send out the draft position paper that addresses flaring as a CMM end use and a draft update to the technology database. If time allows, we will discuss these pieces. If not, we will solicit feedback in writing.
