Airport Information	The Jakarta International Airport is about 25km/17 Miles or about 45 minutes from the Sultan Hotel Jakarta.
Transportation to The Sultan Hotel Jakarta	TAXI Metered taxis are readily available outside of all arrival terminals. Flagfall is Rp. 3,000 and Rp. 1,300 for each additional kilometer. An additional surcharge from the airport is Rp. 3,000, plus Rp. 8,000 for the tollroad. Taxis are the best way to get around, especially in the cities. Make sure the driver knows where you're going before getting in, and make sure he uses the meter. If he refuse, just get another taxi, they're usually not hard to find.
Visa Information	All travelers to Indonesia must be in possession of a passport that is valid for at least six months from the date of arrival, and have proof (tickets) of onward or return passage.
	The following countries DO NOT need a visa in order to enter Indonesia:*
	Brunei Darussalam, Chile, Ecuador, Hong Kong SAR, Macau SAR, Malaysia, Morocco, Peru, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam.
	The citizens of all other countries are required to obtain visas for transit through Indonesian airports
	Visa-on-Arrival: The Indonesian Government extends Visa on Arrival (VoA) to nationals of the following countries:
	Algeria, Australia, Argentina, Austria, Bahrain, Belgium, Brazil, Bulgaria, Cambodia, Canada, China, Cyprus, Czechoslovakia, Denmark, Egypt, Estonia, Fiji, Finland, France, Germany, Great Britain, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, India, Iran, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Kuwait, Laos PDR, Latvia, Libya, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxemburg, Maldives, Malta, Mexico, Monaco, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Oman, Panama, Poland, Portugal, Qatar, Romania, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Africa, South Korea, Spain, Suriname, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, Tunisia, the United Arab Emirates, and the United States of America.
	The VoA can be obtained at Soekarno-Hatta International Airport and is valid for 30 days.
