# **Subcommittee Achievements since January 2009**

#### 11th Session of the Coal Mine Subcommittee

- Held in conjunction with 5th Session of the UNECE Ad Hoc Group of Experts on Coal Mine Methane in Geneva
- Over 40 attendees representing 11 countries
- Focus on 2010 Expo planning



## Subcommittee Achievements since January 2009 (cont'd)

#### M2M Expo

- 36 New Project Opportunities for Expo Display
  - China: 7
  - India: 12
  - Kazakhstan: 1
  - Mexico: 2
  - Mongolia: 2
  - Poland: 7
  - Russia: 1
  - Ukraine: 4
- 2 Success stories from China project opportunities displayed at 2007 Expo
  - Chongqing Mine (VAM Project)
  - Songzao coal mining area

#### 2009 M2M Grant Solicitation

- Awarded 6 grants in coal sector
  - 4 in China, 1 in Poland, 1 in India



## Activities by Country

#### Australia

- Australian Government policies aimed at widespread deployment of low emission coal technology by 2020:
  - National Low Emission Coal Strategy
  - Global Carbon Capture and Storage Initiative
- Carbon Pollution Reduction Scheme
  - Emissions trading scheme to commence 1 July 2010, to cover fugitive emissions from coal mines.
  - Coal sector transitional adjustment measures:
    - \$750m package over the period 2010/11 to 2014/15, to assist coal mines with high fugitive emissions.
    - Includes \$250 million to support technology deployment.



#### China

- China and U.S. agreement to work together to develop up to 15 large-scale CMM projects in China under the Strategic Economic Dialogue (SED).
  - US EPA provided financial support for three recentlycompleted full-scale feasibility studies:
    - Songzao Coal Mining area in Chongqing
    - Hebi coal mining area in Henan Province
    - Liuzhuang coal mine in Anhui Province
  - US EPA is providing on-going financial support for two fullscale feasibility studies:
    - Lan Shan Mines in Inner Mongolia
    - Lin Hua Mine in Guizhou Province



### China (cont'd)

- New projects funded through US EPA M2M grant solicitation in 2009:
  - Prefeasibility study for two coal mines in Guizhou Province
  - Inventory of abandoned mines in Shanxi and Hebei Provinces
  - Analysis of current coal mine gas recovery and utilization technologies used in China
  - Analyze efficiency of existing CBM/CMM recovery projects in Shanxi Province and develop recommendations to enhance recovery
- Continued US EPA support for China Coalbed Methane Clearinghouse, hosted by China Coal Information Institute (CCII)



### China (cont'd)

- Release of IEA report on CMM in China
- Successful workshops in Jincheng, Chengdu, Beijing
- 9 CMM projects to be showcased at 2010 M2M Expo
  - 7 new projects and 2 success stories



#### India

- Strategy: Focus on VAM, new CMM project development and capacity building through India CMM/CBM Clearinghouse.
- India CMM/CBM Clearinghouse on-going in Ranchi at the Central Mine Planning and Design Institute.
- CMPDI is pursuing an R&D project for identification of prospective areas for CMM development within the command areas of Coal India Ltd.
- VAM project development and capacity building, with Coal India Ltd. under the Asia Pacific Partnership Coal Mining Task Force.
- CMM projects to be showcased at 2010 M2M Expo



#### **Mexico**

- Government of Mexico recently released national climate action report, which includes focus on methane, M2M, and a CMM project in northern Mexico.
- U.S. EPA funding a demonstration project (CMM to LNG) in the Sabinas coal basin
- 2 CMM projects showcased at 2010 M2M Expo



### Mongolia

- Mongolia Nature and Environment Consortium completed a U.S. EPA M2M grant for a prefeasibility study at the Nalaikh mine
  - Possible Global Environment Facility follow-on project.

#### Nigeria

 U.S. EPA completed grant for pre-feasibility studies at the Onyeama and Owukpa mines in the Enugu coal field.



#### Poland

- U.S. EPA awarded two grants (2008).
  - Assessment of VAM resources at 10 gassy Polish mines, with the Central Mining Institute in Katowice (on-going).
  - Feasibility study at the abandoned Zory mine, to convert CMM to LNG (complete).
- U.S. EPA awarded one grant to CMI (2009)
- CMM projects to be showcased at 2010 M2M Expo



#### Russia

- IEA working on CMM regulatory analysis and outreach in Russia
  - Funded by U.S. EPA (launched in 2008)
  - CMM Workshop in Moscow (May 2009)
  - IEA Report on Coal Mine Methane in Russia (Dec 2009)
- 1 CMM project showcased at 2010 M2M Expo



#### Ukraine

- Inter-agency Working Group on Mine Degasification and CMM Collection and Use (Feb. 2009)
- Green Tariff Law (April 2009)
- Law on Coalbed Methane (Spring 2009)
- ARENA-ECO collaborating with policymakers to encourage and facilitate CMM project development
  - Work coordinated by Battelle, sponsored by U.S. EPA
  - Round Table on Promoting Use of CMM with the Ukrainian Parliament Committee on Fuel held in April 2009
  - White paper: Reducing Methane Emissions in the Coal Mining Sector in Ukraine
  - Report: Analysis of International Best Practices for CMM Recovery and Utilization
  - CMM Investment Promotion Forum in Donetsk in May 2010
- 4 CMM Projects showcased at 2010 M2M Expo



#### United States

- Strategy focuses on promoting CMM development in the US and internationally:
- Continued enhancement of financial model
- Technical and analytic support for new projects in US and internationally.
- US EPA currently soliciting grant proposals to support Partnership.



#### United States (cont'd)

- Support for international projects
  - 12 new and ongoing projects in China, India, Poland, Mexico, Mongolia.
  - 2 full-scale feasibility studies underway in China.
  - Support for capacity building initiatives.
    - China and India Clearinghouses.
    - Russia and Ukraine in-country organizations.
- 2009 U.S. CMM Conference
  - Boulder, CO September 30-October 1.
