

 - Explore GMI and finance






Methane Expo 2013

- 12-15 March 2013 in Vancouver, Canada.
- Premier global forum focused on methane, held ~ once every 3 years. Previous Expos held in Beijing (2007) and New Delhi (2010) were huge successes, with over 500 attendees each.
- Format:
 - Plenary session covering cross-cutting issues (e.g., financing)
 - Site visits for several sectors
 - Concurrent sector-specific sessions covering technical and policy issues
 - Exhibition hall showcasing project opportunity and success story "posters" as well as technology providers and key stakeholders
 - Steering Committee and (5) Subcommittee meetings
