


Domestic Initiatives The Voluntary Scheme of the Keidanren

As a whole: "To reduce CO2 emissions below the 1990 level by the fiscal year 2010"

Entities participating:

33 sectors

1990 emissions: 508mil t (40% of national emissions)

Assessment as of JFY2006:


Achieved interim targets: 21 sectors (Chemicals, Cement, Gas.....)
Have not achieved interim targets: 12 sectors (Power, Steel, Paper...)

Follow-Up:

8 sectors agreed to tighten their targets
In a need to tackle the "Office etc. Sector" → Hospitals and Schools

Domestic Initiatives The Power Sector

Voluntary Target: reduction of CO2 emissions (by unit) by 20% from 1990 during the JFY 2010 → from 0.421kg-CO2/kWh to 0.34kg-CO2/kWh
