


Kazakhstan O&G Sector Introduction

- Production of oil was 86.2 mln. tons (2017) :
 - production increase mainly from three major projects: Kashagan **8.3** mln. tons, Tengiz **28.7** mln. tons and Karachaganak **12.5** mln. tons
- Oil exports amounted to 69.8 mln. tons (2017) (planned 87 mln. tons (2018)):
 - The technical feasibility of exporting the country is about 100 million tons (KPC 52 million tons, Kazakhstan-China-20 million tons, Atyrau Samara-18 million tons, seaport 5 million tons and railway 5 million tons).
- Oil refining volume 14.9 mln. tons (2017)
 planned 15.8 mln.tons (2018).
- Petroleum bitumen production was 731.1 thousands tons.

Kazakhstan O&G Sector Introduction

Production of APG was 52.9 bln.m³ (2017) planned to produce 53.4 bln.m³ (2018) :



Volume of exported gas was 17.2 bln.m³ (2017)

For the first time, gas was exported to China in 2017, its volume was 1.1 billion m3.

Planned to increase economic cooperation and increase gas exports to China to 10 billion m3 in 2018.





Methane Action Plans

- Since 2014 several methane LDAR campaigns conducted by JCS NC "KazMunayGas" at production facilities in 3 regions (together with Carbon Limits, EPA).
- Planned to conduct one more LDAR pilot in Mangyastau region in 2018.
- JCS NC "KazMunayGas" joined to GMI Project Network (2017)
- Ministry of Energy joined to O&G
 Subcommittee





Emissions Trading System

- Methane emissions regulated as a pollutant (taxes) and a greenhouse gases (reporting).
- 2013 ETS launched in Kazakhstan
- 2016 ETS suspended
- 2018 ETS restarted
- The new National Plan for the allocation of greenhouse gas emission quotas for 2018-2020 is approved. 2 methods of allocation: historical and benchmarks
- International Center for the Development of Green Technologies and Investment Projects
 Energy of the Future will start of work in 2018
