# Oil and Gas Subcommittee - Statement of Purpose

The **Oil & Gas Subcommittee** is committed to providing international leadership to mitigate global methane emissions through the abatement, recovery and use of methane from oil and gas operations as a clean energy source.

The Oil & Gas Subcommittee encourages collaboration between delegates from Partner Countries and Project Network members to build capacity, develop strategies and markets and remove technical and non-technical barriers to methane mitigation project development in order to increase environmental quality, improve operational efficiency and strengthen the economy, from the additional gas brought to market.

## Oil and Gas Subcommittee - Structure

- Chairs/Co-Chairs (up to 3)
  - Lead strategic vision
  - Nominated by Partner Country
  - Two year term (can be extended by subcommittee)
- Subcommittee Membership
  - Open to any and all Partner Country Delegates and Project Network members as well as collaborating organization representatives
- Collectively, through consensus they:
  - Set a robust management structure
  - Provide institutional leadership and consistency
  - Engage the Project Network members
  - Maintain an open and welcoming forum



### Oil and Gas Subcommittee Key Activities (2016-2017)

- Participated in 8 workshops and meetings
- Held 6 stakeholder meetings with Partner countries and/or Project Network Members
- Conducted 5 on-site studies, including methane measurement and site surveys
- Provided technical assistance and outreach



## **GMI Oil and Gas Strategic Alliances**

- 2) Share technical resources and support the development of work products
- 3) Streamline on the ground efforts (i.e., measurement studies) to maximize impact





### **Moving Forward**

- Co-locate GMI Oil and Gas Subcommittee annual meetings with UNECE Group of Experts on Gas meetings (2019)
- Support the development/dissemination of GMI/UNECE Best Practice Guidance for reducing methane emissions from the (1) upstream oil and gas industry, and the (2) downstream gas industry
  - Case studies and BMPs for MRV and reducing methane emissions
  - Development of training modules
  - Capacity-building seminars and workshops
